O predavanju

Tradition can nowadays serve as one of the marketing strategies for promoting various places, objects, activities ... as well as manifestations at national parks. In the lecture the so called traditional manifestations of the three national parks will thus be considered: at the only Slovene national park, Triglav national park, and at two Bosnian national parks, Kozara and Sutjeska. Despite their different histories all three mentioned parks nowadays promote themselves at least partially also with their so called traditional manifestations. The author will therefore present these manifestations their organisers consider as traditional and analyse to which parts of the histories these manifestations relate to, what they intentionally underline while on the other hand miss out or silence. At the same time the focus of the analysis will be on the transformation of the ideas about traditionality over time, space and in various sociocultural contexts. The lecture will nevertheless focus on contemporary situations and raise questions about emancipatory potential of (Yugo)nostalgia, silenced heritage and nationalisms.

O predavačici

Mateja Habinc is an assistant professor at the Department of Ethnology and Cultural Anthropology, Faculty of Arts, University of Ljubljana. She is the head of the department for the Ethnology of Slovenia focusing her research mainly on the (post)socialist period of the country. She researched (state) holidays, objects of memory, heritagisation while lately she is interested in the second-hand retail with clothing. She published two books: "*Gresta v nedeljo popoldne na pokopališče?*": o skrbi za grobove in njihovem obiskovanju na primeru brežiških pokopališč od tridesetih let 20. stoletja do danes ("Are you going to the cemetery on the Sunday afternoon?": On visiting and tending graves – the case study of cemeteries in Brežice since 1930's until present) and *Ne le rožmarin za spomin: o spominskih predmetih in njihovem shranjevanju* (Not only rosemary for keeping memory: On objects of memory and their keeping).
